I) Rules & Regulations

- This is an Online Photography Competition on Ganpati Festival.
- Subject/Category/Theme of the Competition -
 - I. Ganpati Idol
 - II. Moods, Expressions & Emotions of Ganpati Festival – Capture the various expressions of devotees in the celebration of Ganpati Festival.
 - III. Bappa Story - A 3 Photo story of Ganpati Festival.
- This Competition will showcase the celebrations of Ganpati Festival from your city, streets and houses. It can be small details from young people to elders, from streets to pandals, from musical instruments to colors, from lighting to darkness, from players to enjoyment. Human Beings & Festival, people involved directly indirectly in festival (Positive or Negative).
- There are no Geographical Boundaries for the Subject/Category.
- A participant can participate from anywhere in the world.
- A participant can participate in all the 3 categories. He can submit a maximum of 2 photographs for the categories - Ganpati Idol & Moods, Expressions & Moods of the Ganpati festival. And for Bappa Story, a participant has to submit 3 photographs and depict a story through the 3 photographs.

2) Age Groups

- The Competition is open for all age groups.

3) Photo Submissions

- The registration forms will be available at http://bit.ly/BG2020_Registration from 23rd August 2020.
- Last Date of Submission is 6th September 2020.

4) Digital Criteria

- Uploaded Photos must be saved as JPEG Only.
- Images Collected from Registration form will be considered as final images for the competition.
- Avoid using Watermarks & Signatures.
- No Borders are allowed in the photographs. The Image should be edge to edge.
- Photos captured using DSLR & Mobile cameras, both are permitted.
- Files for Upload must not be larger than 2mb.
- Digital adjustment/editing is acceptable only up to a certain limit. The faithful representation of what you saw at the time of the shot being taken, must be maintained.

5) Terms

- Entry Fee per participant per category is Rs. 100/-.
- For Out of India participants, the Entry Fee per category is \$ 5.
- Photograph size should be 12 by 18 with 300 dpi.
- Any photograph submitted must be the entrants own work.
- Participants should note that the photos to be submitted in this year's competition must not have been submitted in any of the previous years of Bappagraphy. Such photos won't be considered in the judgement of the competition.

6) Judging

- Judge will be done by a panel of Bappagraphy nominated judges.

7) Winners for Category “Ganpati Idol” will get vouchers worth

- 1st Prize – Rs. 3000/-
- 2nd Prize - Rs. 2000/-
- 3rd Prize - Rs. 1000/-

8) Winners for Category “Moods, Expressions & Emotions of Ganpati festival” will get vouchers worth

- 1st Prize – Rs. 3000/-
- 2nd Prize - Rs. 2000/-
- 3rd Prize - Rs. 1000/-

9) Winners for Category “Bappa Story” will get vouchers worth

- 1st Prize - Rs 3000/-

I 0) Winners for Highest Voted Photograph

- Facebook & Instagram's Most Popular Photograph also stand to win special gifts.

I 1) Organisers Rights

- Organizers have all the rights regarding the competition.
- Judge's decision(s) would be final & the prizes can't be exchanged.
- The Prizes to be given out totally depends on the judgement, if the judges think that a particular Prize is not suited among the available entries, it won't be given.
- The organizers reserve the right to reproduce accepted work for contest promotion in both printed and electronic forms.
- Be fair to Compete. Organizers can ask for the original files in case of doubt concerning manipulation.
